Weeks 9-11 PB4L Focus- Be Inclusive over the next couple of weeks we are focussing on being inclusive. We don't want anyone to feel excluded or left out at Colville School.

Impact of Changes to Vaccine Mandate and Red Level at Colville School from 11.59pm on 4.4.22

- No vaccinations required for volunteers
- Removal of any outdoor capacity limits
- Indoors capacity limits at Red, moving from 100 to 200 (but still allowing for one-metre spacing)
- No requirement to display QR codes at any setting
- Usual visitor register processes
- No mask requirements when outdoors (but masks remain a requirement indoors for staff and children/students in Years 4-13 when at Red)
